



Modifications:

- ✓ Site
- ✓ Incision
- ✓ Needle
- ✓ Docking
- ✓ suturing




Advantages

- ✓ Scleral tunnel is easier to construct than a triangular flap.
- ✓ Eliminating the need for suture knot rotation.
- ✓ Suture placement ab externo or ab interno approach.
- ✓ Does not require suture closure.
- ✓ 4 points fixation.



Disadvantages

- ✓ 4 points fixation.
- ✓ Corneal abrasion
- ✓ Bleeding.
- ✓ Wicking of blood into the eye.
